

Spurious Drugs Allegations in Delhi Hospitals Dismissed by DGHS Panel

An internal inquiry by the Directorate General of Health Services (DGHS) found no evidence of "spurious" or "substandard" drugs in Delhi's government hospitals and mohalla clinics. Drug samples collected and tested did not violate the Drugs and Cosmetics 1940. While some Act, medicines were deemed "not of standard quality" due to minor issues like dissolution time, these were not considered criminal acts. The report suggests the original complaint was motivated by professional rivalry or vested interests.

Understanding Inflation

Inflation measures the rate at which the general price level of goods and services increases over time, decreasing purchasing power. It is a critical economic metric affecting households, businesses, and policymaking.

Impact on Households

1. Reduced Real Income:

- Inflation erodes real income (the purchasing power of nominal earnings). For example, a salary of ₹50,000 buys less when inflation increases.
- Households with fixed incomes, like retirees or wage earners, are more severely affected as their earnings don't keep pace with rising prices.


2. Increased Cost of Living:

 Essential goods and services such as food, housing, and healthcare become costlier, straining budgets, particularly for low-income groups.

3. Lower Real Interest Rates:

 Real interest rates (nominal interest rate minus inflation) decrease with higher inflation, reducing the incentive to

How Inflation is Measured

1. Consumer Price Index (CPI):

- Tracks retail price changes in a basket of goods and services.
- Reflects consumer-facing inflation and includes services.
- CPI October 2024: 6.21% (driven by food price inflation).

2. Wholesale Price Index (WPI):

- Monitors wholesale price changes across 697 commodities.
- Excludes services and reflects factory or mandi prices.
- WPI October 2024: 2.36%.

3. GDP Deflator:

- Measures price changes for all domestically produced goods and services.
- Excludes imports and offers a broader inflation measure than CPI or WPI.

4. Producer Price Index (PPI):

 Reflects price changes at the producer level, excluding taxes and transport costs.

5. Wage Inflation:

 Tracks the rate at which wages increase, reflecting labour market trends.
